

## How to get to Turku

*With around 200,000 inhabitants, Turku is a compact and easy-to-navigate city. Despite its size, it is well connected, and public transport in Finland is generally reliable and efficient.*

### By plane - to Finland

Helsinki–Vantaa Airport is Finland’s main international airport, located approximately 170 km from Turku. The airport offers daily direct flight connections from many European cities, as well as long-haul destinations worldwide.

Finnair<sup>1</sup> is Finland’s main airline, and Helsinki–Vantaa is also served by numerous international carriers. Please check the schedule of your preferred airline and book early.

### By plane - directly to Turku

Turku Airport is a small and convenient airport located only 8 km from Turku city centre. A selection of direct flights is available, particularly from nearby European cities such as Stockholm<sup>2</sup>, Copenhagen<sup>3</sup>, Riga<sup>4</sup>, and Gdańsk<sup>5</sup>.

Please check the flight schedules for your preferred route and book early.

### By Boat (Cruise Ship) – via Helsinki Harbour

Helsinki Harbour is one of the busiest passenger ports in the Baltic Sea, offering regular cruise and ferry connections to cities such as Stockholm and Tallinn. Several international cruise and ferry operators serve the harbour, providing comfortable overnight and daytime sailings.

### By Boat (Cruise Ship) – Directly to Turku Harbour

Turku Harbour offers regular cruise and ferry connections, particularly to Stockholm and the Åland Islands. The harbour is conveniently located close to the city centre and is served by major Baltic Sea cruise and ferry operators.

Please check the sailing schedules for your preferred route and book early.

## **By Train**

Travelling by train is a convenient and comfortable way to reach Turku from Helsinki and other parts of Finland. Long-distance trains operate frequently, and the journey offers a smooth and reliable travel experience.

Turku has two main train stations: **Turku Central Station**, located in the city centre (approximately 2 km from the venue), and **Turku (Kupittaa) Station**, which is located right next to the venue and one of the recommended hotels.

Train tickets can be booked via [VR](#). Booking early is recommended, as prices may be dynamic.

## **By Bus**

Travelling by bus is a convenient and economical way to reach Turku from Helsinki and other parts of Finland. Long-distance buses operate frequently, offering a comfortable and reliable travel experience.

Buses stop at several locations in Turku. The main **Turku Bus Station** is in the city centre, approximately 2 km from the venue. Some buses also stop at **Turku (TYKS)**, which is about a 10-minute walk from the venue and nearby recommended hotel.

Bus tickets can be booked via [Matkahuolto](#) or [Onnibus](#). Booking early is recommended, as prices may vary depending on demand.

## **Getting to AHM2026 with public transport**

### **From Turku Airport**

Local bus services operate between Turku Airport and Turku city centre. The journey takes approximately 20–30 minutes.

Bus tickets can be purchased using a contactless payment card, the Föli mobile app, or from ticket machines where available.

### **From the city centre**

AHM2026 can be reached conveniently by local bus or by train to Turku (Kupittaa) Station, which is located next to the venue.

### **From Turku Central Station**

Frequent local buses and trains operate between Turku Central Station and Turku (Kupittaa) Station. The journey takes approximately 15 minutes.

Tickets for local transport can be purchased via contactless payment in the bus or the Föli app.

### **Getting to AHM2026 by taxi**


Taxis are readily available at Turku Airport, train stations, and throughout the city.

Uber and Bolt apps can also be used, though the car availability might be limited.

**From Turku Airport:** approximately 20-25 minutes

**From Turku Central Station:** approximately 10–15 minutes
